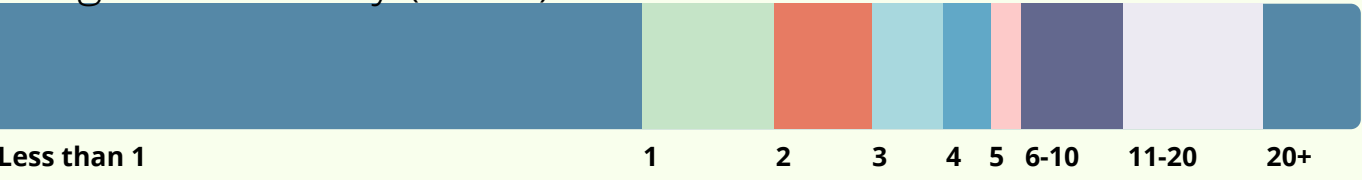


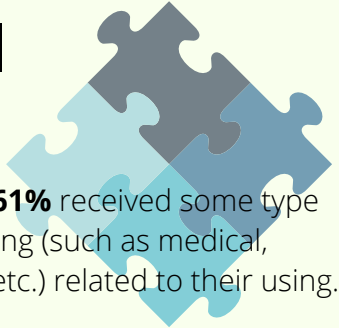

BEFORE coming to MA, **61%** received some type of treatment or counseling (such as medical, psychological, spiritual, etc.) related to their using.

Attendance is an average of **3 MA meetings** per week

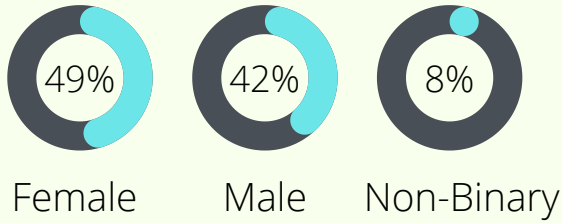


MARIJUANA ANONYMOUS 2021 MEMBERSHIP SURVEY

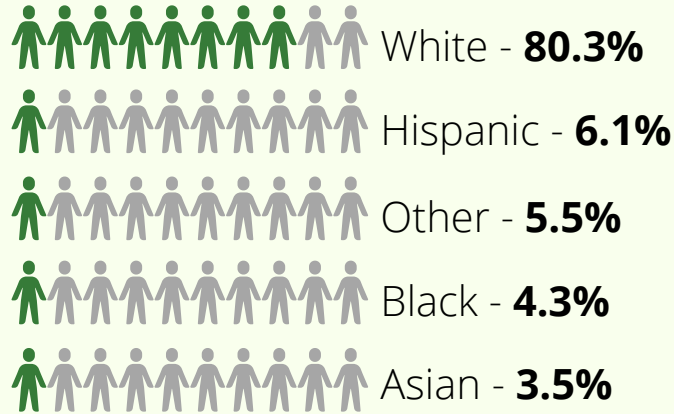

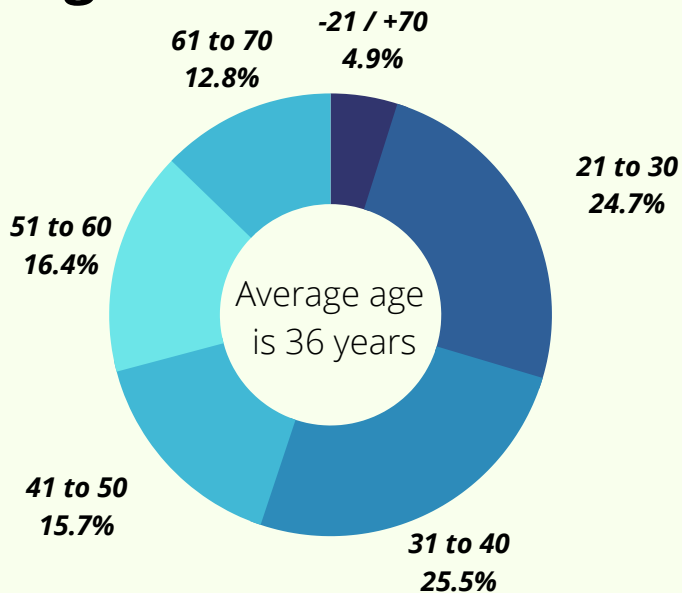
Gender Identity



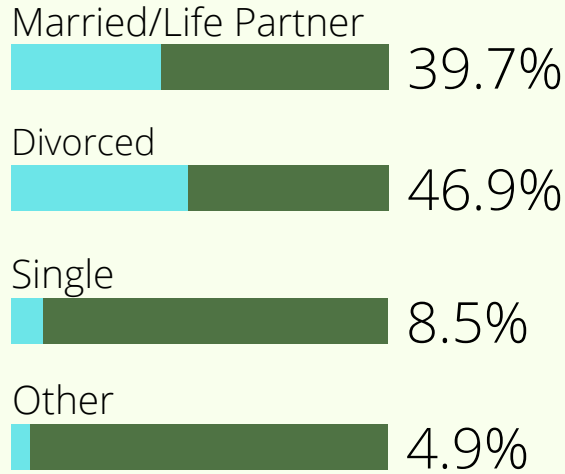
Composition

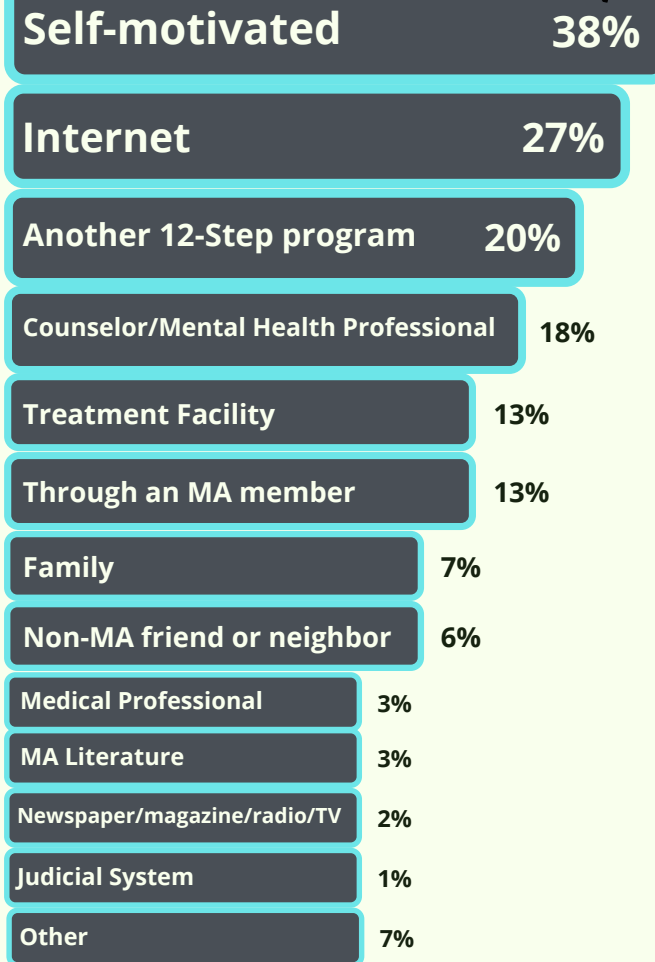


Relationship with Health Care Professionals
